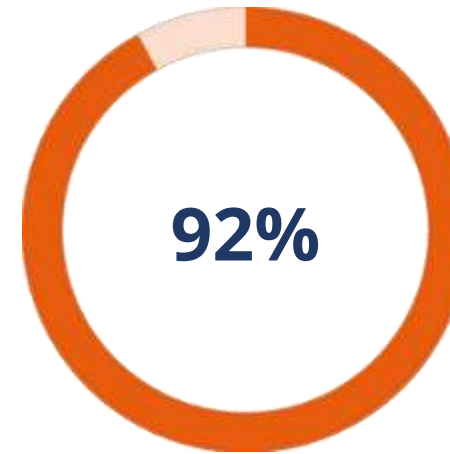
- **Early-stage:** Companies in ideation or pilot phases, seeking validation and initial partnerships.

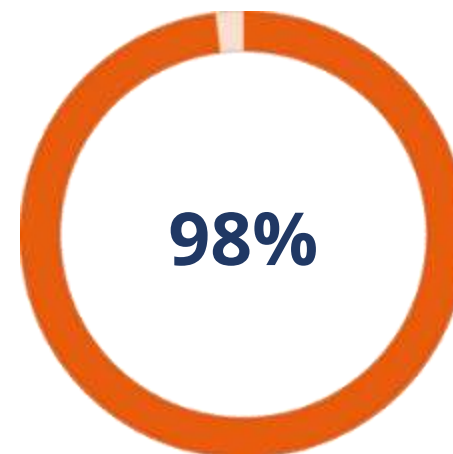

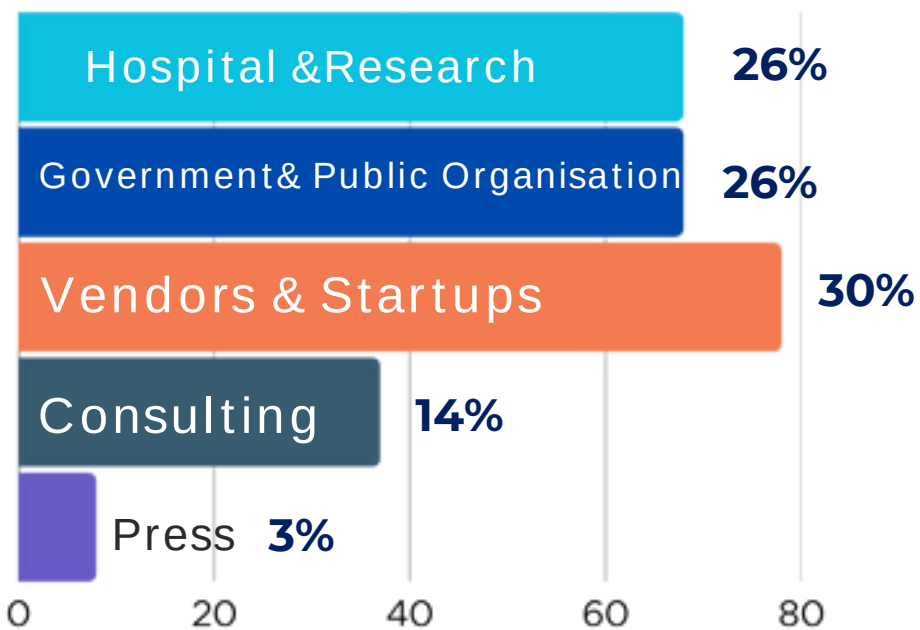
